Seniors Security Subsidy Scheme

On July 1 the City of Rockingham will introduce the Seniors Security Subsidy Scheme.

The scheme will help to improve the level of security for homes of senior citizens with the City of Rockingham contributing up \$100 towards the cost of purchase and installation of a range of security devices including sensor lights, security doors and window screens, home intruder alarms, smoke detectors and property marking kits.

To qualify for the scheme, seniors need to ask these questions:

Do you live in the City of Rockingham?

Are you in receipt of a Pensioners Concession Card or Seniors Card?

Are you thinking of installing additional security in your home?

The Seniors Security Subsidy Scheme is supported by the Office of Crime Prevention and local police.
