

SECRET HARBOUR YOUTH ACTIVATION SPACE – PROPOSED SITE LOCATION

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD –
EXTENDED TO 28 NOVEMBER 2008

The City of Rockingham is currently investigating the development of a Youth Activation Space within Secret Harbour to cater for the recreational needs of local young people. As part of this process an investigation of potential sites has been undertaken with a location on the perimeter of Secret Harbour Oval identified as the most suitable option. This location is centrally located within the suburb, located on public open space, afforded good passive surveillance, located adjacent to the town centre, and can be integrated with existing park uses.

The proposed Youth Activation Space will be a unique facility providing opportunities for structured and unstructured play and socialisation for young people from a range of age groups. Wheeled sports elements will also be integrated within the facility which will ultimately result in the existing foreshore skate park being removed. The facility will be designed through an inclusive design process with local residents, particularly children and young people, given the opportunity to directly influence the facility elements (within a determined scope & budget).
